WHAT IS INTERNET?

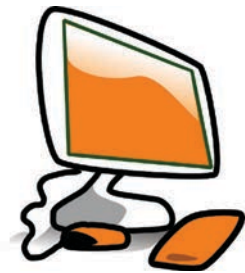
The Internet or simply the Net is a worldwide network of millions of computers. It is an interconnection of large and small networks around the globe.

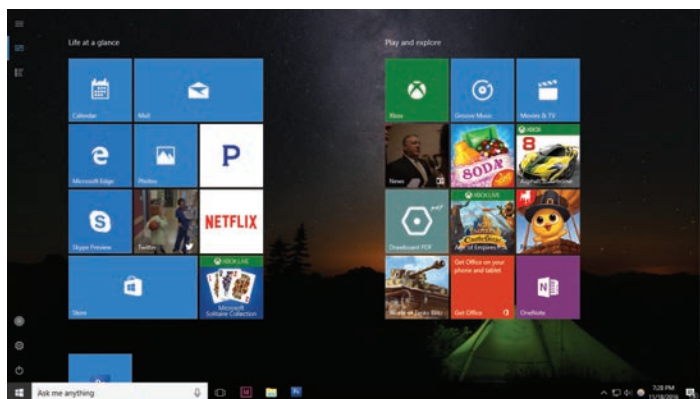
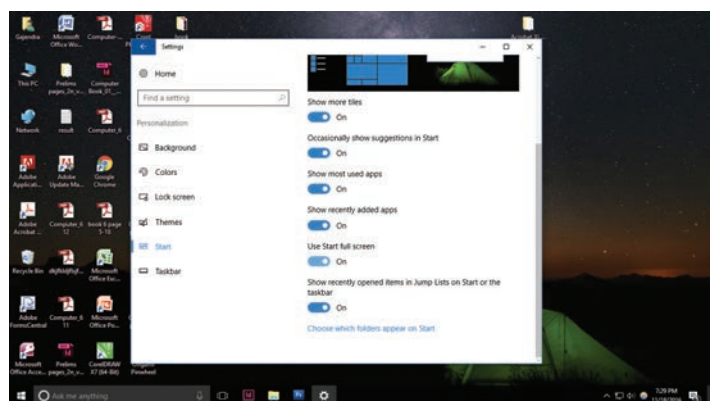


Making Start Full Screen

You can make Start full screen and see everything in one view.

Follow the steps given below to make start full screen:

1. Click on the **Start** button.
2. The Click on **Settings**.
3. Click on the **Start** and then turn on **Use Start Full screen**.



When Start is full screen, select **menu** in the top left corner of the screen to get to the account picture, the All Apps ad Most used list, and the power button.

If you want to resize the Start menu a bit to make it taller or wider, select the top or side border and drag it.
