The names of the first three animals start with the letter '**b**'; and the names of the rest of the animals start with the letter '**c**'.













In order to arrange these in the alphabetical order, look for the second letter in the words beginning with '**b**' first. Then, look for the second letter in the words beginning with '**c**'.

We add **s** with some nouns to form the plural number.



We add **es** to some nouns to form the plural number.
